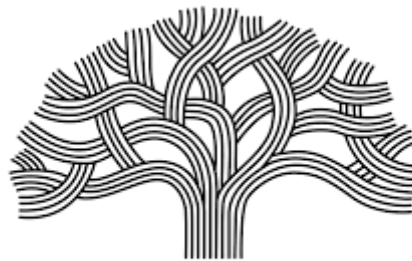

All public speakers will be disconnected from the line after all comments are heard and council will proceed with Closed Session.
