Parking Policies & Procedures

Updated 3.16.2022

The DOSC Parking Permit sticker cost is \$8.00. This is a Parking Control & Maintenance fee, and it helps offset the cost of the security guard.

Only one (1) parking permit will be sold to each DOSC member. No Exceptions!

A <u>current</u> Dept. of Motor Vehicles (DMV) registration must be presented at the time the parking permit is issued - <u>No Registration</u>. <u>No Permit</u>. <u>No Exceptions!</u>

Having a DOSC Parking Permit **DOES NOT** guarantee the owner a parking space.

- All vehicles, <u>including those with Disabled Parking Placards</u>, are required to have a Downtown Oakland Senior Center parking permit to park on this lot.
- Permits should be placed in the left-hand side rear window. If there is not rear window or it is tinted, please place in the passenger side of the front window.
- The cost of replacement permits will be \$12.00. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Parking permits may only be purchased by <u>members</u> of the Downtown Oakland Senior Center, City of Oakland Aging and Adult Services staff, Head Start staff, Veteran staff, and Aphasia staff.
- DOSC Parking Permits <u>are not</u> transferable. They are specific to the vehicle identified at the time of purchase.
- No parking is allowed on the Center's lot for reasons outside of Downtown Oakland Senior Center or Veteran's activities, **even if you have a permit**.
 - o If you are parked in the lot before 9:00 a.m., or on the weekends, you may be ticketed.
- No parking in spaces with signs that designate specific staff members; and
 - No parking in spaces with orange cones (designated for teachers/staff);
 - No parking at red curbs, in driveways, or in unmarked spaces;
 - No entering the lot from the EXIT driveway (Grand Ave.).
- When the lot is full, cars must wait in line for the next available space.
- Vehicles guilty of violations are subject to being towed.
- Violations of these procedures may result in the revocation of your DOSC Parking Permit.
