

From Archeo-tec:

Today we focused on the paved area to the north of the spot we were investigating yesterday. We discovered a large, relatively intact fragment of a concrete foundation that appears to be from a building that we think was erected between 1902 and 1912. Little else was found today. No artifacts were associated with the concrete foundation remnant. Also, of particular interest, no traces of the 19th century Chinese community was uncovered. For the most part, sterile sub-soil was encountered just below the asphalt and rock base, less than 1 foot beneath the ground surface. Topographically, the area we investigated today appears to have been cut down, perhaps by as much as 3-4 feet, at some point during the last century. Because of this, we found no evidence of significant archaeological remains today.
