On behalf of the Measure DD Coalition, we are pleased to provide this letter of support for the Oakland Museum of California's Community Anchors project. The Museum's Executive Director Lori Fogarty, and the project's architect and landscape architect recently presented the project to the Coalition. We were delighted to see how beautifully the project enhances the Measure DD-funded improvements at the south end of Lake Merritt. We fully support the Museum's efforts to serve as a welcoming, accessible and relevant educational resource, cultural destination, and gathering place for Oakland. The OMCA project promises to advance the IMLS's objective to strengthen communities by advancing local economic, physical, and/or social outcomes.
